

## STANDARDS MANAGER GENERAL CHANGES


- Standards Manager now can export the database to an SQLite (\*.sqlite), not just an SQL Server Compact File (\*.sdf). In our testing, we found that the SQLite file is much faster than an .sdf file.

# STANDARDS MANAGER LAYERS PALETTE




This palette is now modeless and can be docked and manipulated similarly to all AutoCAD palettes. The reworked look is also more streamlined for user efficiency. With the tabs on the palette the user can easily navigate all layer commands at once.




### STANDARDS MANAGER CONVERSION PALETTE

New to CAD Standards Manager 2022 is a central palette for all conversion capabilities. Layers, text styles, dimension styles, and multileader styles now can be converted in a single modeless palette. Sorting and filter capabilities have been enhanced, while speed and accuracy have been maintained.



#### STANDARDS MANAGER STYLES PALETTE

All the database styles are now contained in a single modeless palette to be easily imported into the current drawing.



#### SYMBOLS, DETAILS & SHEET BORDERS PALETTE

This modeless palette has been re-worked for speed & efficiency. The query capability has been improved to find the content quickly.
